At the July 2015 meeting of the National Architectural Accrediting Board (NAAB), the directors reviewed the *Visit and Report (VTR)* for the Catholic University of America, School of Planning and Architecture.



As a result, the professional architecture program **Master of Architecture** was formally granted an eight-year term of continuing accreditation.

The term is effective January 1, 2016. The program is scheduled for its next visit for continuing accreditation in 2023.

First, all programs must submit an Annual Statistical Report (see Section 10 of the NAAB *Procedures for Accreditation*, 2012 Edition, Appendix). This report captures statistical information on the institution and the program.

Second, a program that receives an eight-year term of accreditation is required to submit an *Interim Progress Report* two years after a visit and again five years after the visit. This requirement is described in Section 11 of

2012, the first interim progress report is due November 2017.

Finally, under the terms of the 2012 *Procedures for Accreditation*, programs are required to make the *Architecture Program Report*, the *VTR*, and related documents
